This fee covers the following:

- 20 weeks of acting, vocal, and choreography instruction and experience through rehearsals and production
- show t-shirt
- 2 show tickets
- 1 show DVD (per family)

Stagelight Productions (SLP) is a ministry of Arise Christian Academy and is a non-profit group. All fees will be used to pay for rights and royalties to perform the show, scripts, Slayton House rental, sets, costumes, props, and the many other expenses that go into producing a stage musical. Stagelight's Vocal Director and Choreographer are the only paid staff. *Participation fee must be remitted via PayPal, check, or cash by the first rehearsal, along with the signed Parent Agreement Form.

Fundraising

While the actor participation fees will cover a portion of our expenses, they do not provide for all the production costs. Therefore, to make our production financially successful, each cast

member must participate in all fundraisers we hold, including securing sponsors, selling program advertisements, etc. Every family must obtain <u>at least \$100</u> in sponsors and/or advertisers for our program and participate in our additional fundraising efforts.

Rehearsal Schedule

A detailed schedule will be provided once rehearsals begin. The general rehearsal schedule is presented below. Please keep in mind that your actor will not be required to attend every rehearsal, but instead will be called by scene, only as needed. However, most actors who have lead or supporting/featured roles will be needed at most rehearsals.

Please note: actors who miss more than three rehearsals for which they are scheduled (and only for valid reasons, e.g., SAT testing, illness, or family emergency) will be dismissed from the cast. If you have questions, please speak to Pamela Fahs.

Statement of Faith. Parent Responsibilities

- Read through the student contract with your student before he or she signs it (distributed after casting).
- Bring your student to rehearsals on time; pick him or her up on time.
- Provide basic costume pieces as needed.
- Participate on a Stagelight parent team. See below.
- Assist your student in raising at least \$100 in advertisers or sponsors for our show.
- Assist your student in participating in our other fundraising efforts.
- Invite family, friends, and neighbors and anyone else you can think of to watch your student perform!

Costumes

Most costume pieces will be provided; however, cast members may have to purchase some. Cast members will need to provide their own shoes as well as some other basic items.

STATEMENT OF FAITH Arise Christian Academy/Stagelight Productions

We believe

- That the Bible is the inspired, inerrant, and authoritative Word of God. (II Timothy 3:16)

- That the Christian is enabled to live a godly life by the indwelling of the Holy Spirit. (Galatians 5:22-25)
