Information for Stage Crew/Tech Team

Serving on the Stage Crew or Tech Team for *Mary Poppins* is a huge commitment, and I am so grateful for your willingness to serve. Students and parents should read this information carefully before applying.

Eligibility. Homeschooled students in 9th grade and above may apply to serve on the Stage Crew/Tech Team. The team will be limited to a certain number of students, depending on our show's needs. (There may be exceptions for highly mature, responsible 8th-grade students.)

Statement of Faith. As a Christian ministry of Arise Christian Academy, all performers and stage/tech crew members must sign ACA's Statement of Faith, stating that they wholeheartedly agree with and will abide by all elements of the Statement of Faith. We take very seriously a student's agreement with our Statement of Faith, so we ask students to carefully read it and prayerfully consider their signature and its meaning before the Lord before signing and applying.
